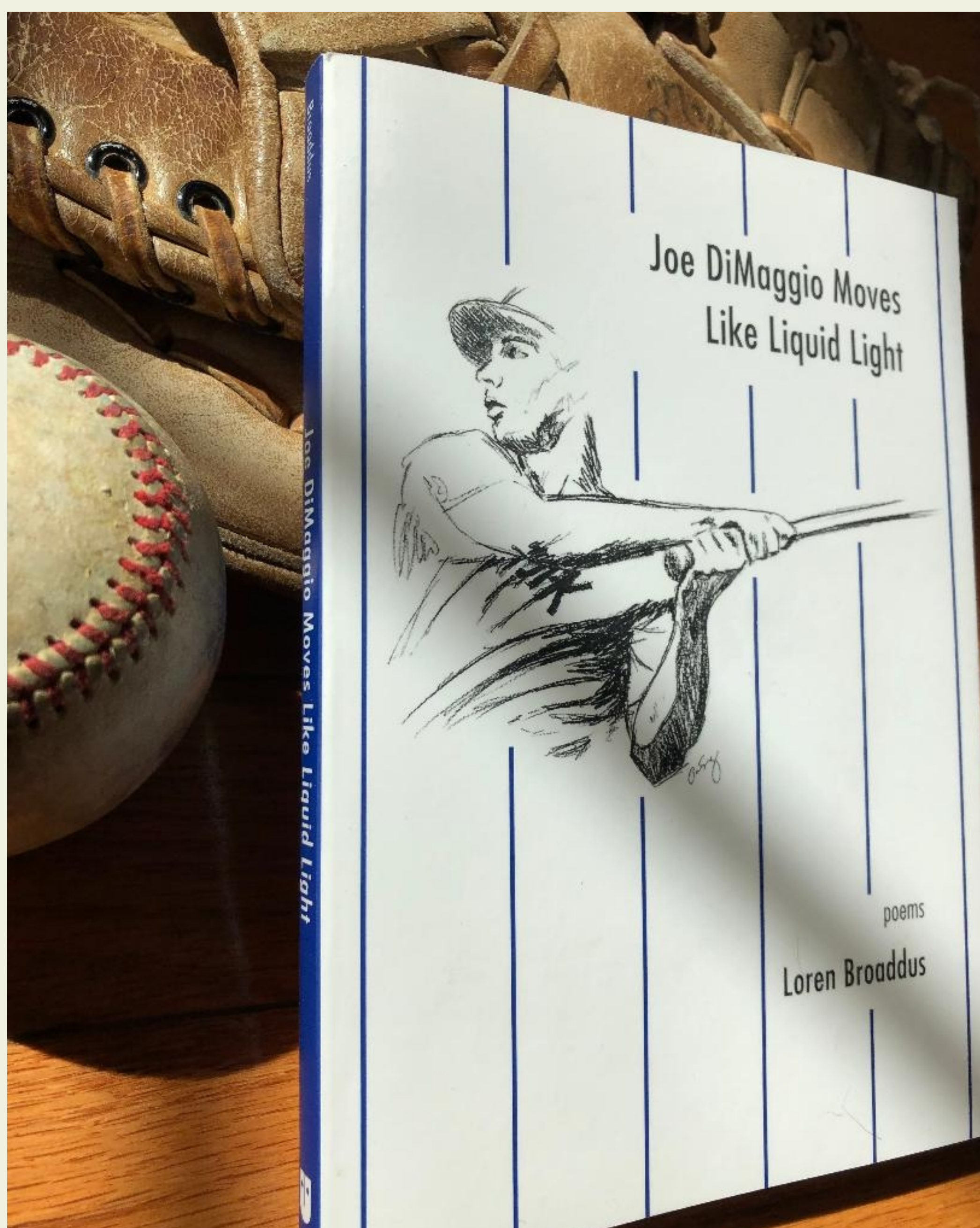


Loren Broaddus
